Intern/Apprentice Ensemble Meetings: Every Friday afternoon

Summer Season Strike: Monday, August 20 (until 5pm)

Picnics and Cast Parties

Picnics are the second Tuesday of each run. Cast Parties are the last Friday.

PERFORMANCE DAYS AND CURTAIN TIMES:

Thu: 7pm; Fri & Sat: 8pm; Sun: 7pm (except *FINAL Sun of each run, which is at 2pm*)

Matinee: 1st Saturday of each run at 2pm

(Additional weekday school matinees will be scheduled in the spring & fall.)

REHEARSALS:

Rehearsals are generally held at LNT or Montpelier High School

(located approximately one mile from the theater)

Days: Tuesdays — Sundays

Production/Technical staff work the Monday before opening

Hours: Between 9:00AM and 10:00PM for a maximum seven hours.

Summer: 9/10am-1pm & 2-5pm Tu-Su until production week (then 2-5pm & 6-11pm)

Spring/Fall: typically 2-5 & 6/7-10pm Tu-Fri; 10am-1pm & 2-5/6pm Sat & Sun

Actors begin rehearsals “Off Book”.
